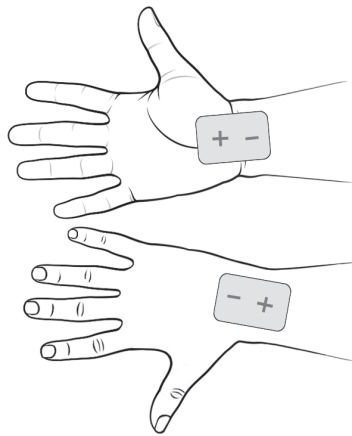


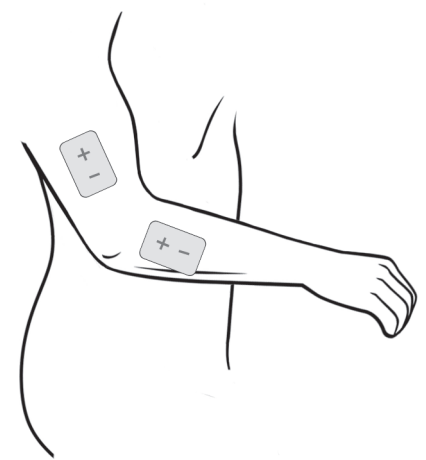
PLACEMENT GUIDE FOR 2 WIRELESS ELECTRODE CONTROLLERS

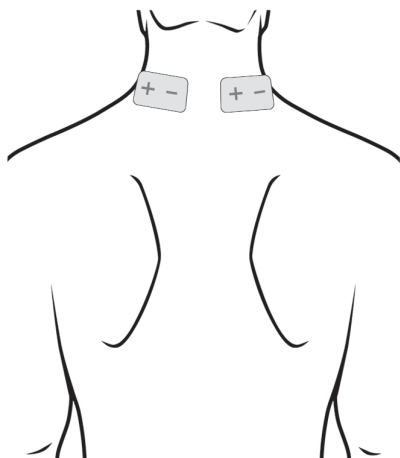
Never remove the self-adhesive electrodes from the skin while the device is turned on.



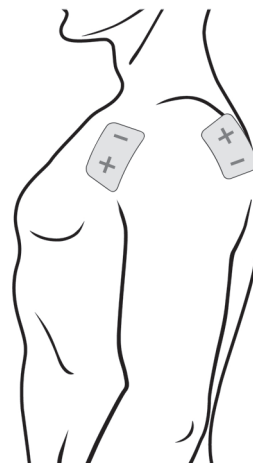

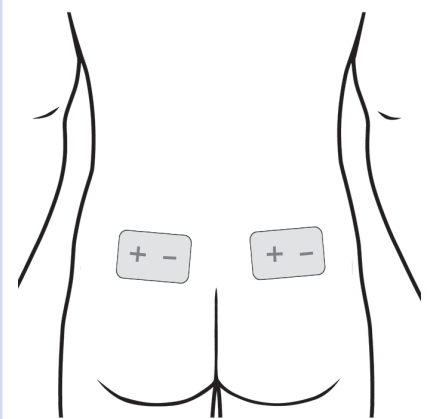

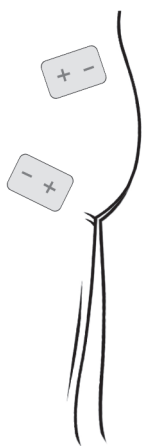

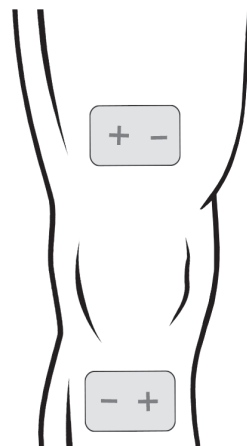

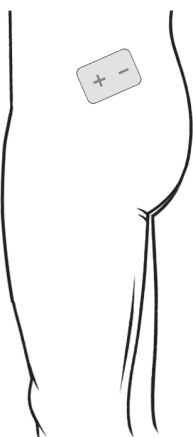
